Airlines to introduce new SAF surcharge in 2025

From 1st January 2025, a mandatory Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) blending quota of 2% will be implemented for all air freight departures from European Union (EU) and the UK. This initial legislation is seen as a key component of the broader strategy to achieve net-zero emissions by 2050.

Due to the increased costs of Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) compared to conventional jet fuel, airlines will implement a SAF surcharge for all exports from the EU/UK starting 1st January 2025. This surcharge will be calculated per kilogram, however the specific fee to be applied by each airline is yet to be confirmed. Given the circumstances, NNR will be obliged to make a similar surcharge to our customers.
