Welcome to MATRADE Loftus Road - the historic home of Queens Park Rangers and the heart of today's celebration and thank you for being here.



Chloe Cooper, QPR Trust's Inclusive Projects Officer, said: "NNR understand


what family and community engagement means here at QPR."

OPR FC Women have come to the end of a strong league campaign, which ended with the team in 5th position, behind a highly competitive leading pack of Real Bedford, Norwich City, Chatham Town and London Bee's. This included enjoyable runs in The FA and Women's National League Cups, despite an early exit in the Capital Cup to Tottenham Hotspur U21's. This was the first year that the Women's department was aligned under the umbrella of the Club, which welcomed some exciting changes. New Head Coach, Danny Harrigan, took the reigns in July, and looks forward to a second season in charge. There were 11 new faces through the summer, which welcomed some much-needed experience and depth to the squad. Whilst Izzy Owen and Annie Dzyadyk made the step up from the Reserves programme, showing the Club's belief and opportunities within its pathway for younger players.
